I General overview

Date

2 - 7 August 2018

Participants are requested to be arrive on 2 August at Incheon International Airport and leave the Jamboree site on 7 August 2018.

(*IST : 31 July – 7 August 2018, International Service Team are encouraged to be arrived a day before beginning of Jamboree)

Venue : Mt. Seorak(World Jamboree Complex), Gangwon province

(244, Jaembeori-ro, Toseong-myeon, Goseong-gun, Gangwon-do, Republic of Korea 24766)

- Description : The venue is the place hosted 17th World Scout Jamboree in 1991, surrounded with beautiful mountain scenery and legacy of world scout Jamboree.
- Location : The Jamboree Venue located in Gangwon province, which located in east side of korea peninsula. Also, There is close to the venue of 2018 Pyeong Chang Olympic Winter Games.



Accessibility

- Main entry : The official entry point will be the Incheon International Airport. We will provide inland transportation between Airport to Jamboree venue.
- Distance : Around 270Km from the Incheon International Airport to the venue. It takes 3hours to reach by bus.



Climate and Weather

- Generally cool with breeze. sometime blow the gust of wind.
- Temperature : 27~31°C / Humidity : 70% ~ 83%

Registration process

- Registration including participant and IST must proceed through National Scout Organization with their endorsement letter and attached registration form. We will not accept individual registration.
- The attached Registration Form should be completed and sent to international@scout.or.kr by **31st May 2018**. The form should be filled in using the excel spreadsheet. Information such as T-shirt size, arrival & departure itinerary is essential to prepare for the jamboree.

Participant and leader Eligibility

- Participant : Young people (Boys and Girls) aged 12 - 17
- Leader : Aged over 18

International Service Team(IST)

- Aged over 18
- IST candidates will be asked to choose their three preferred assignments. IST prospects for positions will be selected by 5th International Patrol Jamboree staffs.
- IST candidates are able to choose following area;

Site management & Safety	Safety Patrol, Site maintenance,
Food Distribution	Food delivery and distribution, Managing staff dining hall
Event & Ceremony	Prepare the international night and support the Arena event

International service	Support the international contingent, Interpreting & translation

Participation Fee

- Jamboree only
 - Participants, Unit leader : USD 250
 - International Service Team : USD 200
 - Fee covers inland transportation between entry point to Jamboree Venue, tentage, meals and programme.
- Special programme
 - Peace trekking : USD 50 (If you choose this one, you can not attend the Jamboree)

- There will be 21 Sub-camp during the Jamboree. Each Contingent will batch the sub-camp in random. If your Contingent have a sisterhood partnership between our regional council of Korea Scout, We may consider to allocate its Sub-camp in advance. It should be noted to us before **31 May 2018**.

Home Hospitality

- Home Hospitality for a maximum of 3 days before or after the Jamboree will be arranged for overseas participants who are willing to have more experiences in Korea. Please check your preference in the registration form, then we will allocate the household for your arrangement. Household would be selected in random.
- If your contingent has already arranged the extra programme with sisterhood Regional council of KSA, Please note to us and proceed with them.

Extra days Programme

- Contingent plans to stay before or after the Jamboree, We can offer the Extra days programme. The programme covers all arrangement by KSA, It would offer reasonable price for international participant.
- The course will be 3 day programme that travel to Seoul or other attractive cities in Korea. We also can arrange the schedule by your preference. For more details will inform in next bulletin and reserve it through international team of KSA.

Solidarity Programme (Operation Seorak)

- To extend the solidarity of scout movement and share the friendship, Korea scout Association operate the invitation programme for overseas participant. It will be inform to every regional support centre in April and grant to every 6 regions of NSO which is in Category A and B.
